RESTRICTED BURNING PERIOD

Are you prepared? The restricted burning period is now in place from 19 September – 31 October 2020.

Permits are now required

Due to the soil dryness which is currently at mid-November levels permits for burning large piles of trees/rubbish will not be issued.

You can be bushfire prepared by reducing fire hazards on your property. This includes mowing/slashing, spraying weeds, and installing compliant mineral earth firebreaks.

You can refer to your Fire Control Order for more information about specific requirements for townsite land, rural residential land and farming land. This can be found on the Shire's website, or available by contacting the Shire Office.
