PINGELLY INDUSTRY ATTRACTION PROGRAMME—FIRST RECIPIENT

The Shire has recently established the Pingelly Industry Attraction Programme. This programme is comprised of two funds—one for business planning and the other for the attraction and development of businesses for Pingelly. This Programme has seen significant interest from within Pingelly and further afield.

The Shire is now proud to announce the Programme's first recipient—First Avenue Trading. Council, following consideration of their business plan, awarded this business \$5,000 toward their initial set up costs on a 50/50 basis.

First Avenue Trading's proposal is for:

- A new high street location is intended to increase the core business of screen printing through greater viability and foot traffic;
- The expansion of services to include alterations and embroidery; and
- Expanding into a souvenir and gift shop for Pingelly themed screen printed products.

This business is due to open its doors shortly. Stay tuned for more announcements from them.

First Avenue Trading is an existing business within Pingelly, currently operating as a home business. Following the announcement of the Pingelly Industry Attraction Programme, First Avenue Trading met with the Shire, prepared a business plan (with the help of RSM Business Local who provide free assistance with business plans) and submitted the business plan to the Shire. Council then granted the funding as it meets the criteria set in the Pingelly Industry Attraction Policy and will activate a vacant shop front on the Parade Street.
