

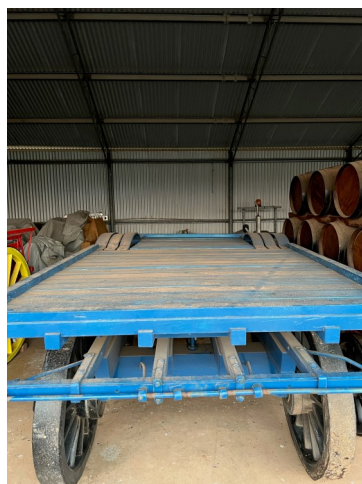
WAGONS ROLL IN!

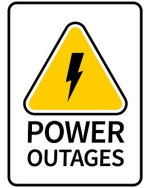

RESTRICTED BURNING PERIOD



The Shire of Pingelly advise that the Restricted Burning Period will be extended from 29 March to 12 April 2023 (inclusive) this will include Easter.

Note that there will be no permits issued for burning over the Easter period from midnight Wednesday 5 April 2023 to midnight Monday 3 April 2023.

If the Shire receives more significant rainfall during this time, the Chief Bush Fire Control Officer may decide to revoke the Restricted Burning Period and remove the requirement for a Permit to Burn at that time.
