## COMMUNITY PARKS WATER SCHEME UPDATE

Last year the Shire implemented the Community Water Scheme which was to provide water security and reduce the dependency on potable water for our parks and Town Oval. Underboring (drilling to install pipework underneath roads and rail) was completed at 4 locations within Pingelly. These are: underneath Park Street near the school; Quartz and Paragon Street junction; the railway line and Parade Street next to the Town Hall. The Community Water Scheme will supplement the existing portable water and replace it with a mixture of dam and bore water, ensuring a decrease of water wastage and costs for the future. This project is possible after acquiring a grant through the Water Corporation for \$97,365 earlier in the financial year. The Community Water Scheme is now in the next stage of laying the piping after identifying the utilities of where the pipes will be laid. The various locations of which the pipes will be laid out are marked around town with orange flags.
