PROHIBITED BURNING NOW IN PLACE

As of November 1, 2023, a Prohibited Burning policy is now active and will remain in force until March 1, 2024. It is essential to comply with firebreak requirements for the

entirety of this period. Properties under 2,024m² are required to clear all flammable materials and maintain grass height to no more than 100mm. For lands exceeding 2,024m², it is mandatory to establish 3-meter firebreaks encircling the premises and each structure. То obtain crucial contact information and detailed guidelines, kindly refer to the fire notice enclosed in your rates package or visit the municipal office to collect one. Your cooperation ensures community safety during this critical period.
