### **27 PARADE STREET PURCHASE**

The Shire is pleased to announce that we have purchased 27 Parade Street (the old Central Garage) on behalf of the community.

Following on from the adoption of the Culture and Art Framework, the Shire intends to create an Art and Craft Precinct incorporating 27 Parade Street, Gnalla Wangkiny Pocket Park and the RSL building. This Precinct is planned to help rejuvenate the southern end of the town centre.

The Art and Craft Precinct will be a place for all of the community to pursue their respective arts, including new spaces for art which requires more space, or is messy including pottery; painting; candle making; metal work etc. This adds to the existing performance and meeting space in the Gnalla Wangkiny Pocket Park. These additional spaces will foster art and craft within our community, increasing the liveability of our town as people are free to pursue their passions and explore new hobbies.

A committee has been formed from the Culture and Art Framework to progress this initiative and manage the facility to ensure access for all when completed. A grant for the redevelopment of 27 Parade Street has been submitted to the Commonwealth Government. The Shire is awaiting the outcome of this grant.
