## NEW BULK WASTE TRAILER

The Shire of Pingelly is stepping into the future of waste management by acquiring a new hydraulic bulk waste trailer. This comes as a replacement for the traditional skip bins that have been made obsolete with the introduction of the Work Health and Safety Act.

Starting from Monday and running through to the next Monday, the bulk waste trailer will be made available for use by the community. The Shire's dedicated crew will handle the drop-off and collection process, ensuring a smooth and convenient experience for all users. This schedule provides flexibility and accessibility, accommodating the various community needs. Residents who were previously listed for skip bin services will be given priority access to the new bulk waste trailer. Shire staff will reach out to these people directly to inform them of the transition and confirm their continued participation. ## ROAD CONSTRUCTION WORKS COMPLETED

The Shire of Pingelly depot crew has successfully completed the road construction capital works for the 2023/24 on time and within budget. This construction includes reconstructing and sealing portions of the Yenelling, Wickepin-Pingelly, and Aldersyde-Pingelly Roads. This achievement is thanks to the Shire's dedicated and efficient works team. These projects also highlights the importance that the Shire places on maintaining and improving our rural roads.



## CARAVAN PARK WORKS COMMENCED

The Shire staff have also commenced work on the caravan park. Work completed to date includes repaving the brick area in front of the toilet block and camp kitchen to remove the various changes in levels. This makes the area accessible to all and removes all trip hazards. Renovations and upgrades to the camp kitchen are currently underway. These enhanced facilities will enhance the overall experience for all park users.
