The National Tidy Town's 'Community Health & Wellbeing' category was awarded to the Virtual Village on Saturday 04 April 2024. The Shire of Pingelly is proud and pleased to congratulate everyone involved with the Virtual Village for this well deserved success. Awards were held in last year's winning town—Gascoyne Junction, WA.

The Tidy Towns judges commented that *'through the provision of vital services funded by home care packages, seniors now have the opportunity to age gracefully in the comfort of their homes, preserving their dignity and cherished connections.'*

The Virtual Village, spanning across Wickepin, Wandering, and Pingelly, has brought together 180 members, creating a supportive environment. This pioneering initiative has garnered national attention, with 19 other communities adopting similar models.'
