The Shire of Pingelly is pleased to announce the successful completion of all tree trimming activities for the 2023/2024 financial year. This year's program focused on maintaining safety and visibility on key roads, with significant work completed along Jingaring and Bullaring roads. The Shire's dedicated maintenance team has worked diligently to ensure these areas are now clear of overhanging branches and potential hazards, enhancing the safety for all road users.

In addition to tree trimming, the Shire of Pingelly has been actively working to improve accessibility and inclusivity across the community. Recognising the importance of creating an environment that caters to the needs of all residents, the Shire has initiated several projects aimed at enhancing disability access.

Key among these initiatives is the installation of wheelchair-accessible ramps at two prominent locations: the Shire Office and the Pingelly Recreation and Cultural Centre (PRACC). These ramps are a significant step towards providing access to all community members, regardless of physical ability. The construction of these ramps is progressing well, with the foundations laid and final touches expected to be completed by next week, weather permitting. Once finished, these additions will provide vital support to residents and visitors with mobility challenges, reinforcing the Shire of Pingelly's commitment to fostering an inclusive community.
