Community Grants 2019/20

Community Grants have now opened for 2019 and close on Friday 29 March 2019. This is an excellent opportunity for local community groups, clubs and organisations to secure some funding. All applications must be submitted to the Shire office by 29 March 2019 to be considered. Once all applications are assessed they will be put to Council for consideration for the 2019/20 financial budget. Once this process is completed you will be notified of the outcome in the form of a letter as per the Community Grant Scheme guidelines.



Please note the funding policy guidelines that if your application is successful Council's contribution will generally be limited to one third of the total project value up to \$5,000. Each application needs to outline matching in kind or matching funding to support your application.

Grants are generally paid on submission of receipts and evidence of project completion. This may be varied by prior agreement with Council.

Works Update

- The Work for the Dole participant has been helping Parks and Gardens Staff around town with garden maintenance and have now started to assist the Contractors who are laying the synthetic green for the new bowling green.
- Review Street Road construction is ready for the cement stabilising contractors who will start work on Monday the 18th of February. The bitumen two coat seal is scheduled for Thursday the 21st of February. Motorists are advised traffic management will be on site and to follow signage and speed limits set. Due to one way traffic flows on Review Street during construction times some road closures will be in place for traffic entering Review Street from Realm, Stratford, James, Raglan, and Shannon Street during construction times.
- A grave will be prepared next week for a funeral at Moorumbine Cemetery on Friday the 22nd of February.
- Preparation for the road construction crew is well advance to start reconstruction work on a section of York Williams Road between North Wandering Road and Ulbrich Road. Motorists are advised to take care and follow traffic management signage as the work is on a crest and bend.
- The Shire staff have started preparing costing for the 2019/20 budget.


