Blessing of the Roads 2019

The Blessing of the Roads campaign is aligned with Towards Zero, WA's road safety strategy 2008 – 2020, which follows the globally-recognised safe system approach to work towards a long term vision of a road transport system where crashes resulting in death or serious injury are virtually eliminated.

Works Update

- The Parks and Gardens Team have continued with their town maintenance program.
