Works Update

- Gravel sheeting work has been completed on Milton Road between Bullaring Road and Woyerling Road.
- Potholes will be patched on various roads over the next week now the weather has improved.
- Stabilising work to repair road failures on Aldersyde Road is scheduled to start on Tuesday the 10th of September and should be completed by late September. Motorists are advised traffic management will be on site and to follow signage and speed limits set.
- Winter maintenance grading work has been carried out on Jingaring and South Kweda Roads.
- Storm damage repair work on Jingaring Road has been completed. Five roads on the western side of Pingelly still need drainage repair work done to finalise the WANDRRA claim.
- Traffic counters have been installed on Avery South, Bassendean and Gillett Roads.
- Spraying of weeds on town reserves will commence next week.
- Sand will be taken to the oval next week for the interschool sports carnival jumps.
- Soil has been installed in the planter boxes at the PRACC.
