Look out for Snakes!

As the weather warms up snakes are becoming more active. Please keep the following in mind to help avoid snake bites.

- Walk loudly - snakes will generally move away if they hear you coming.
- Be aware that snakes may be slower to move away in the early morning or on cool days and may be sunning themselves to warm up.
- Wear sturdy boots (and gaiters if required), look where you place your feet.
- Never place your hands into crevices or areas where you cannot see what may be lurking.
- Reduce likely habitat aspects, such as areas of cover or snake food (mice etc).
- Remember that you should never disturb or harass a snake, not only may you get bitten but they are protected by law.
- Always have a first aid kit available.

The Restricted Burning Period will begin on 19 September 2019. Please be advised that from this date until 31 October 2019 a permit is required for any burning carried out.

Fire hazard reduction works are required to be completed by 31 October 2019.

Works Update

- Gravel sheeting work has been completed on Milton Road between Bullaring Road and Woyerling Road.
- Potholes will be patched on various roads over the next week now the weather has improved.
- Stabilising work to repair road failures on Aldersyde Road has commenced and should be completed by late September. Motorists are advised traffic management will be on site and to follow signage and speed limits set.
- Winter maintenance grading work has been carried out on Jingaring and Dwarlarking Roads.
- Green waste piles will be burnt at Pingelly Landfill site on Friday the 13th of September.
- Storm damage repair work on Jingaring Road has been completed. Five roads on the western side of Pingelly still need drainage repair work done to finalise the WANDRRA claim.
- Traffic counters have been installed on Avery South, Bassendean and Gillett Roads.
- Spraying of weeds on town reserves will continue next week.
- Tree contractors are being organised to prune trees on road verges which Western Power have advised as being too close to power lines.
