## Harvest Ban Information for 25 & 26 December 2019 & 1 January 2020

The Shire of Pingelly would like to advise that on Christmas Day, Boxing Day and New Years Day there is a total harvest and movement of vehicles ban in paddocks except for the watering of livestock.

The Boxing Day ban may be lifted at 4.00pm on that day if the weather conditions permit.

It is also reminded that we are in the Prohibited Burning Period and the use of whipper snippers, mowers and slashers on dry grass is not permitted between 6.00am and 6.00pm during this period.

It is okay to trim, mow or slash reticulated (green) grass e.g lawns, lawn edges. Please read your Fire Control Order received with your rates notice for more details.



At last week's Council meeting the following items were discussed:

- ♦ Trial of Overnight Recreational Vehicle Stay Area
  - Community feedback will be sought in 2020 in relation to a proposed overnight stay area in the Pingelly townsite for fully self contained vehicles.
- ♦ Australia Day Awards 2020
  - Council considered nominations for the Australia Day Awards, to be presented at the Australia Day Breakfast on 26 January 2020.
- ♦ Tender 03/2019-20 Provision of Medical Services
  - Council confirmed a long term commitment to Agape Ventures Pty Ltd, Pingelly's current supplier of medical services.
- ♦ Request for Quotation Kerbside Waste and Recyclables Collection
  - Great Southern Waste will continue to provide the kerbside waste and recyclable collection service for the next 3 years.
- Proposed Telstra Telecommunications Facility
  - An additional facility was approved by Council to reduce the black spots approximately 10 kilometres west of the Pingelly townsite.
